- Local interns may also attend local productions and help Producers on set.

POST-PRODUCTION

- Post-Production interns work alongside the Post-Production Coordinator and Post-Production Assistants to assist with content screening and network deliverables.
- Become familiar with all aspects of the post-production workflow from initial footage ingest to final color and audio mix.
- Aid in the completion of post-production documents including, but not limited to music cue sheets, final show scripts, interview transcriptions, and footage logs.
- Local interns may shadow Assistant Editors to learn the fundamentals of Avid Media Composer.

DEVELOPMENT

- From researching new show ideas to writing treatments, interns will learn how to take an idea and mold it into a marketable TV show pitch.
- Work side by side with the development team to research, develop, and pitch new show ideas.
